PCSI Food Pantry Offers Groceries, Choice, and Support

PCSI's Food Pantry serves Pittsburgh residents at our North Craig Street office. Customers may visit once per month and choose from available foods, including nutritious groceries and healthy recipe ideas.

The pantry is open Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM, and Thursday from 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM.

First-time visitors should bring photo ID, proof of Pittsburgh residency, household income information, and ID for household members. Bring grocery bags if you have them.

If you registered for PCSI services in 2026, such as workshops, Pr.E.P School, or utility assistance, **you are already registered for the food pantry**. Come back and pick up groceries when you need them.

Build Job Skills with Pr.E.P School

Looking for a job, returning to work, or ready for a better opportunity? PCSI's Pre-Employment Preparation (Pr.E.P) School helps City of Pittsburgh residents ages 18 and older build the skills and confidence needed to find and keep a good job.

This free, two-week program meets Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from August 3-14, 9:30 AM to 2:00 PM, at PCSI's North Craig Street office. In six sessions, participants learn practical ways to prepare for work, communicate with employers, and feel more confident in the workplace.

Free Resume and Interview Workshops at PCSI

Looking for work or ready for a better opportunity? PCSI offers free Resume Building and Interview Prep workshops on the fourth Tuesday of each month at our North Craig Street office.

The Resume Building Workshop meets from 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM and helps participants learn the basics of resume writing and build a personalized resume. The Interview Prep Workshop meets from 1:00 PM to 2:00 PM and helps participants prepare, practice, and feel more confident during interviews.

Participants may attend one or both workshops, depending on their needs. Workshops are open to City of Pittsburgh residents ages 18 and older. Free parking is available, and the office is accessible by several bus routes.
